The police department received 1346 calls for service from 04/01/25 – 04/30/25. 18 Adults and Juveniles were either arrested or summoned into court for various charges to include: Carry Dangerous Weapon, Distribute Class B Drug, OUI-Liquor, Possess Class B and C Drugs and Violate Abuse Prevention Order. There were Thirty Two (32) Motor Vehicle Accidents investigated. 5 People were taken to the hospital for a Mental Health Evaluation. Officers responded to complaints that resulted in 54 Incident Reports being created for various crimes.
